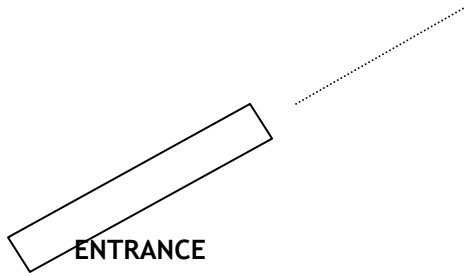
***Today's event will run from 10am until around 3pm.*** The atmosphere is going to be brilliant!

# **RULES**

## ***The Ball***

A size 5 football will be used for the Men's and Women's tournaments and a size 4 for the children's competitions.

## ***Number of players***

Seven-a-side with rolling substitutes at the referee's approval. NO OFFSIDE.

## ***Playing Equipment***

Players must wear shin guards and goalkeepers must wear a distinguishable playing strip.

## ***Fouls & Misconduct***

All free kicks are direct with the opposing team 5 yards from the ball. A free kick will be awarded if the goalkeeper touches the ball with their hands after it has been deliberately kicked to them by a team mate; or after they have received it directly from a throw in taken by a team mate. For these two offences the free kick should be taken 8 yards from the goal line, at the nearest point to the offence. In the event of a penalty kick being awarded – the kick will be taken 1 yard inside the penalty semi-circle and may ONLY be taken by a player on the field of play at the time it is awarded.

## ***Throw-In***

A goal can not be scored directly from a throw-in. The ball must be delivered from behind and over the head using both hands, with both feet in contact with the ground.

## ***Goal Kick***

A player of the defending team kicks the ball from any point within the penalty area. Opponents must remain outside the penalty area and at least 5 yards from where the kick is taken.

## ***Corner Kicks***

Opposing players must remain 5 yards from the ball until in play.

All other rules are as the Laws of Association Football

# **BEHAVIOUR**

The **Mini World Cup** is all about enjoyment of the game and having fun! We want to encourage integration between teams and cultures in Cambridge and Fairplay is the objective of the day.

In cases of poor behaviour, the referee's will be enforcing the following;

## **YELLOW CARD OFFENCE**

If a player receives a yellow card, they will immediately be sent to the **SIN BIN for 3 minutes**. This will be timed by the referee and the player will not return onto the field of play until the 3 minutes is up and after the referee allows him/her to do so. The player in the sin bin can not be replaced by fielding another player during the 3 minutes.

## **RED CARD OFFENCE**

If a player receives a red card or two yellow cards in any one match; they **will not** be permitted to play any further part in this tournament.

***We want to reiterate that poor behaviour of any kind will not be tolerated in this tournament and the referees' decision is final.***

# **SCORING SYSTEM**

## ***Group Stages***

Points shall be awarded in the following way;

WIN = 3 points      DRAW = 1 points      DEFEAT = 0 point

If teams are on equal points, progression will be determined in the following order:

- Goal Difference
- Goals scored
- Result of the game when two teams met
- Penalty shoot out – 3 each then sudden death

## ***Knock out stages***

To determine teams progressing to the next stage, where scores are level at full time then kicks from the penalty mark will be used; 3 each and then sudden death as per the laws of Association Football.
